

Driver Operator General/Pumper, NFPA 1010, 2024 Edition

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The Manitoba Emergency Services College will be adopting the new Driver Operator General and Driver Operator Pumper standard (NFPA 1010, 2024 Edition) as of July 1, 2026. The first offering of this new course will start in the Fall of 2026.

The new NFPA 1010 textbook is: *IFSTA Pumping and Aerial Apparatus Driver/Operator Handbook, 4th Edition.*

As part of the change from NFPA 1002 to NFPA 1010, the following will be updated in order to reflect the new standard and resources:

- Curriculum
- Test banks
- Skill sheets
- Evaluative processes

Testing will continue to be over a two-day period and will include two written exams, one for General and one for Pumper.

NFPA 1010 pre-requisites remain the same as NFPA 1002:

- Active member of the Manitoba Fire Service
- Minimum Class 4 license (full status) with air brake endorsement
- Fire Fighting Level I
- EVDS Seminar
- Pumps Basic Seminar
- Pumps Advanced Seminar
